The Award, initiated in 2008, is named for Sister Alfreda Elsensohn, who founded the Historical Museum at St. Gertrude in Cottonwood. Sister Alfreda, one of Idaho's outstanding historians, sought to collect, preserve, and interpret artifacts from Idaho County and the surrounding area to better educate the public. "A museum is a bridge which links the present with the past," she often said. It is her vision of

Idaho museums as exciting, interactive, and educational institutions that the Award seeks to recognize by honoring one outstanding Idaho museum each year.

- Will have a record of outstanding professional programming
- Will be leaders in the field of Idaho museums.

• Will have a record of sharing their resources and information with other institutions, through such entities as the Idaho Association of Museums, thereby assisting in the professional development of all the state's museums.

- Will be able to use the funding to move to a higher level of professionalism.
- Will have experience in administering and implementing grant-funded projects and programs.
