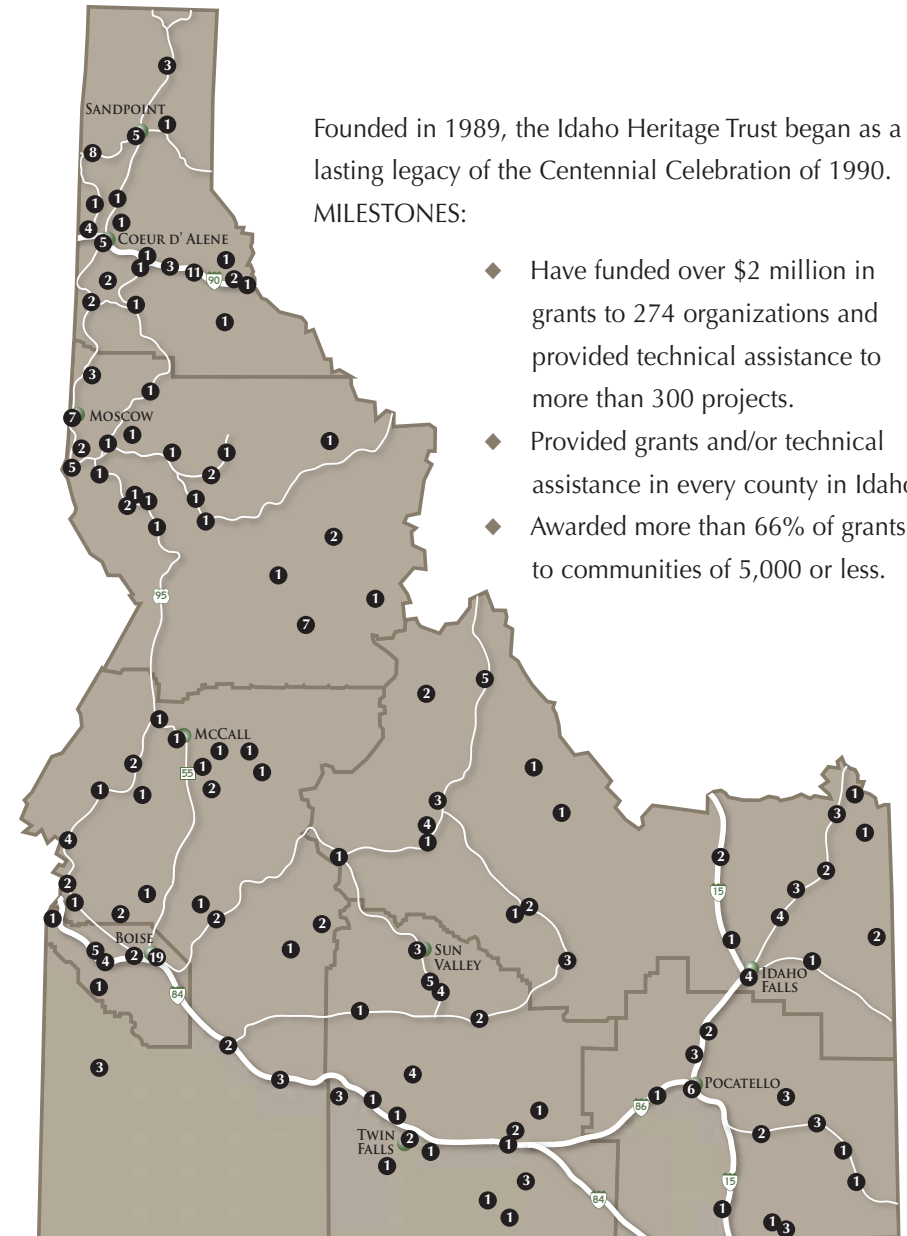

LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The people who founded the Idaho Heritage Trust believed that the identity of our state is grounded in the historic fabric of the state's architecture and archaeological sites and the artifacts and photographs that were and are a defining part of our family and community life. These founders and Idaho's Centennial Legislature created an endowment fund that every year funds the grants and technical

assistance needed to help preserve these symbols of Idaho's history.

In 1990 and 1991 Idaho's corporate and foundation community stepped forward to give the Trust a strong start. Our early partners included Boise Cascade, Albertsons, First Security Bank, the Janss Foundation, the H.F. Magnuson Foundation, West One Bank, Basic American Foods, William Hewlett, the H.J. Heinz Foundation and many more.

In 1993 AVISTA Corporation, then Washington Water Power, entrusted us with an endowment for projects in North Idaho. John Taylor of Lewiston added to the endowment a few years later making it the AVISTA North Idaho Fund.

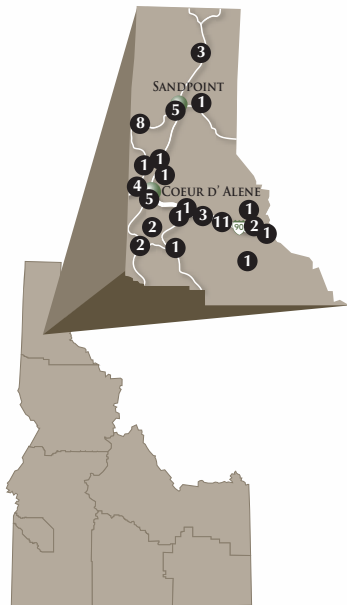
Other corporate partners like Idaho Power, the M. J. Murdock Charitable Trust, Paul Allen Foundation and William Hewlett helped to purchase and thus preserve the pristine Lewis and Clark Camp at Glade Creek in Idaho County.

New partners include the Steele Reese Foundation, Tom May, Battelle Energy Alliance, the Governor's Lewis and Clark Trail Committee, Boise National Forest and others.

Next year The Idaho Heritage Trust will republish our popular Traveling History Book, a publication that plots the Trust's projects along Idaho's roads. The first edition featured 116 projects. The new edition will include over 275. I like to think of the buildings, sites and artifact conservation projects we fund as a nontraditional park, a new way of looking at Idaho's history through the buildings, artifacts and sites along our highways.

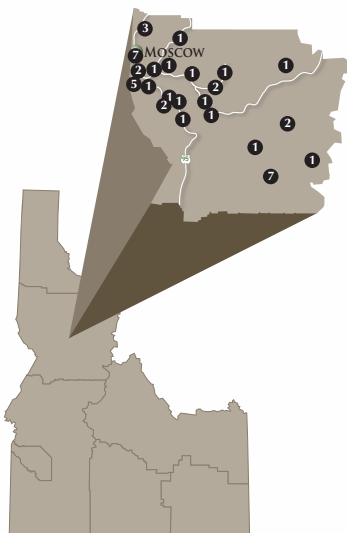

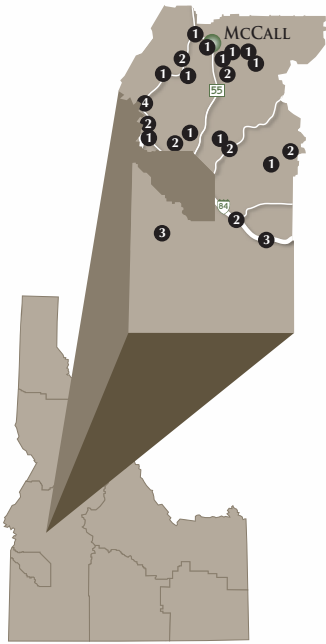

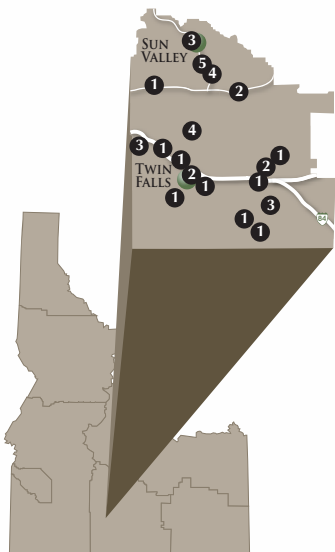

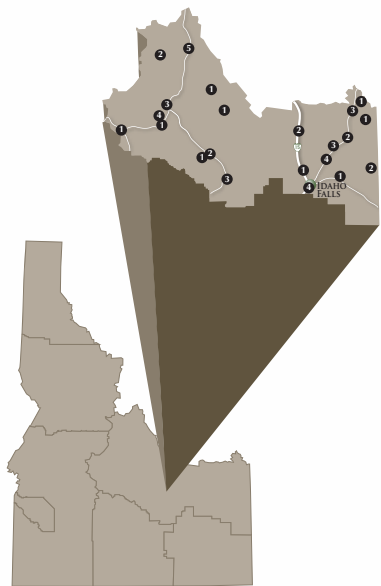
