Paper Presentations

Paper Presentations: Archaeology papers may include research overviews, theoretical articles, works that deal with methodologies, application, best practices, case studies or related issues that are pertinent to the Idaho Archaeological Community. Presentations shall be approximately 15 minutes in length.

Poster Presentations

Posters presentations may include projects addressing Archaeology, Historic Preservation, and Public History.

Space: The Poster display area for graphics and a textural summary is 4 feet (height) x 8 feet (wide). Each space has an area in front where handouts may be placed. Text shall be limited to four or five pages of double-spaced, 16-20 point text. Mounting supplies will not be provided. Presenters need to provide their own easels or pushpins for their displays. Electricity is not available.

Title: Each poster display shall include a lettered sign giving the title and authors. The sign shall be 6 inches in height and up to 8 feet long and be mounted at the top of the board.

Author's Presence: Presenters will be at their poster from 10-11:30 a.m. daily. Since a clear advantages of poster presentations is sustained interaction with the audience, Presenters are encouraged to spend as much of the 90 minutes as possible with their material.
